Reports

Secretary's Report: Minutes from November 15, 2007, were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report: A new account was opened at Umpqua Bank with \$2,888.70 – mostly money earned from the Winter Festival. The US Bank account, with a current balance of \$8,856.87, will be closed.

Winter Festival Results

There was a great turnout for this event with everyone having a really good time and enjoying the music, food, sale items, and SGRIP dancers. The Elks helped keep our expenses down with generous donations of food and raffle items. Money from the various areas was kept separate so we could see where best to concentrate our energies: baked goods brought in \$277, crafts \$615, lunch \$666, and raffle \$1,270 totaling \$2,828. With the Carnival on hold, this was a major fundraising event for PTO this year.

New Business

The Dances are February 8th and 9th in the South Bay Cafeteria. The DJ has been booked and a call for healthy appetizers to give out and baked goods to sell will be sent out to parents. Jeff Conner will take photos in the music room and Shannon will work with Mrs. Burghart to create a backdrop for the pictures. Jennifer will invite some of the SGRIP students to attend and teach our kids some of their moves. Since only \$100 was budgeted to buy items to sell, an additional \$300 was requested and approved. There are also leftovers in storage from last year's dances and the carnival that can be used. Those interested in setting up for the dance should meet at the SB cafeteria on Friday at 1pm. Please plan on staying after either or both dances to help clean up.
