Pancake Breakfast-a HUGE Success!

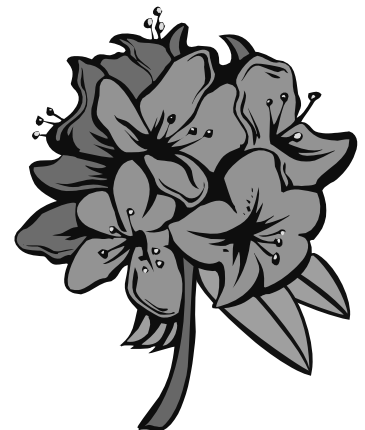
